In February 2017, Lundin Petroleum AB spun-off its oil and gas assets in Malaysia, France and Netherlands into a newly formed company called International Petroleum Corporation (IPC). IPC is a new international oil and gas exploration company incorporated in Canada and IPC's shares are listed on the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSX) since April 24, 2017. In this report, all payments made within 2017 have been reported per NRCan guidance.

All payments are reported in United States Dollars ("USD") which is the reporting currency used in IPC consolidated financial statements. Payments made in currencies other than USD have been translated using a 12 month average exchange rate during the period.
